

## Foreign and old currency



Convert your leftover holiday cash and out-of-date coins and notes into a charitable donation. ### **Give as you Shop!**

If you do any internet shopping at all, then this is one of the easiest ways to help. Every time you go online to shop (Ebay, Etsy, Amazon, supermarkets, high street shops, hotel booking sites, travel sites and a fair few others) you'll be giving towards our Community Hub.



To sign up: Go to [easyfundraising.org.uk](https://easyfundraising.org.uk), then click on the yellow “Sign up and get started” button, then click on the “Support a cause” option.

Search for St Luke's and follow the rest of the instructions.

To shop: You have 2 options.

Go to [easyfundraising.org.uk](https://easyfundraising.org.uk) and click on “Shop by category”.

Use the search bar to find the shop you want, then click on the shop name and you'll get taken to their website.

Or: There is an option to download the EasyFundraising extension (once you are signed in it will be advertised at the top of the page). This will then remind you as a pop up every time you go to a registered site. You just click on the pop up and it will reload the page through EasyFundraising.

If you already have an account please consider changing your chosen cause to St Luke's just while we are fundraising.

Here's how they broadly work. You can either enter information onto the website or download the app and scan barcodes with your phone. You will be given an instant price, if you accept - pack up your items, use the free courier or drop-off service, and get paid via bank account or Paypal.

You may not get as much as you would for individual listings on ebay but doing it in bulk will save you time and hassle!

(You will probably need to select 'I'm riding/skipping/ for a charity not listed on the list below'.)





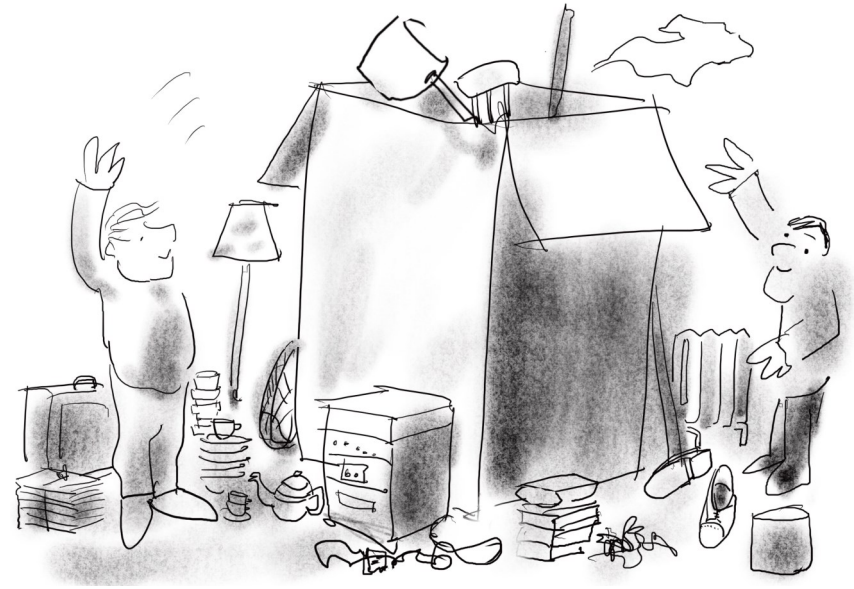
## Set Yourself a Challenge!
